

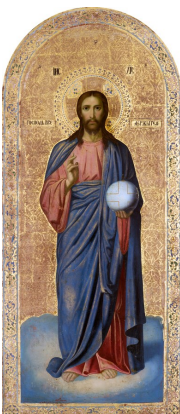

CAPITAL CAMPAIGN ANNOUNCEMENT

Dear Parishioners,

After extensive delays due to our New Orleans heat
we have finally begun to move forward with the termite
damage in our church. This week the contractors will begin
constructing a cat-walk to facilitate that work. Soon there-
after we will be able to secure an estimate for the work that
must be done.

In these past few months, we have worked on other
aspects of the campaign including sealing the exterior of all
the windows, and other work on minor issues which have
arisen. One major issue that intervened was the necessity
to seal the entire structure, and we are about to commence
the contract for that work. We anticipate completion of that
work before the end of the year. As of this writing we have
not decided which contractor to use so we can only say
that the work should cost less than \$400,000.00. We had
not anticipated this work, so this is a new item on our list.

We have started the process of installing new carpet and
changing the seat cushions and kneelers and that work will
begin either right before or right after the first of the year.
Same thing with the communion rail and pulpit.

We have the necessary funds to complete the water-
proofing and carpeting and will have a bead on the cost
for termite work soon after the first of the year.

Finally we have resolved the issue of the roof with the
insurance company and work will begin shortly on installing
a new copper roof on the entirety of the structure at no
cost to us.

With yours and Gods help we will get there. Thanks for
your patience.

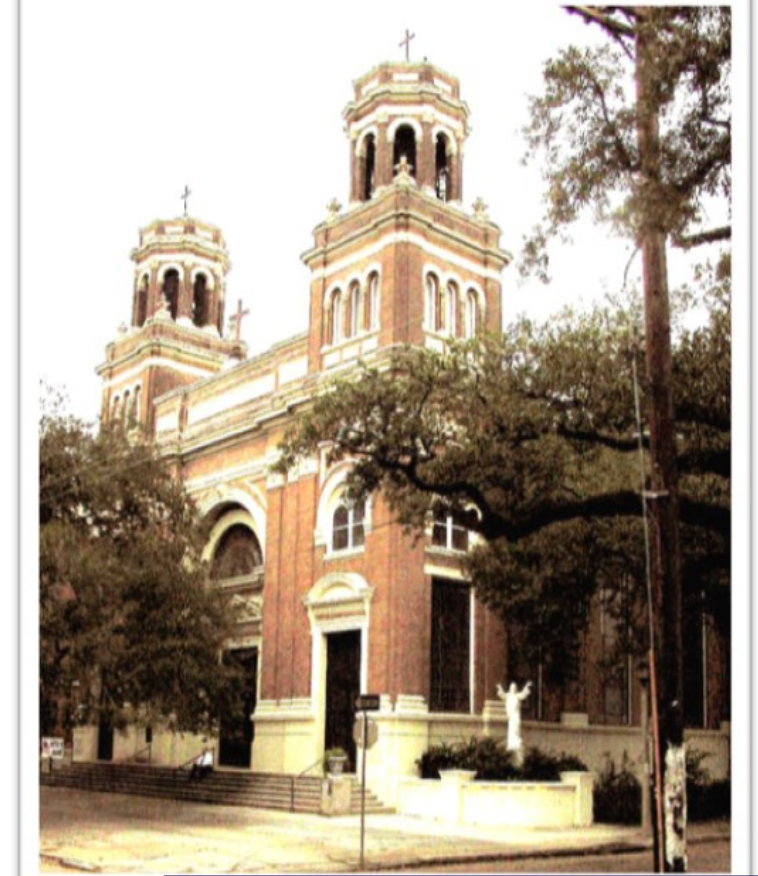
