Rosary for Priests Prayer Group

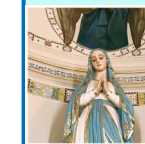

Nov.'s rosary & chaplet is on Nov 15th.

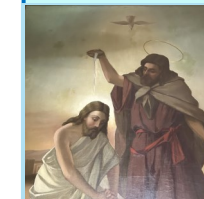

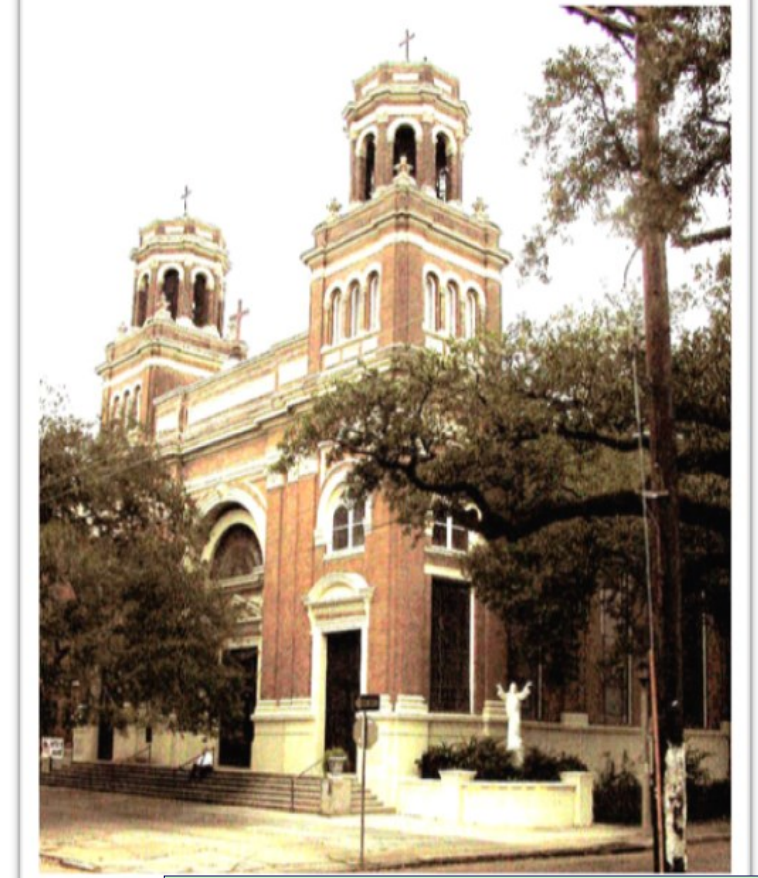
